Luke 22:31 He demands things, he wants to "sift" Peter

John 8:44 He was a murderer from the beginning, there is no truth in him, he is the father of lies

1 Peter 5:8 He is our adversary, he prowls about like a lion, he seeks to devour

Revelation 2:13 He has a throne and lives somewhere

Revelation 12:10 He accuses the brethren before God day and night

3. What do you learn from the following passages about the types of things the devil does or can do?

Matthew 4 He approaches in a time of weakness, he is called "the tempter," he tests, he can transport people places, he knows Scripture and uses it cunningly, he owns the kingdoms of the world, he desires to be worshipped, he left when Jesus told him to

Luke 8:12 He "takes away the word from people's hearts" so they cannot believe and be saved

Luke 13:16 He can bind people for many years through physical illness

John 13:27 He can enter into people

Acts 5:3 He can fill hearts, he inspires lying

1 Corinthians 7:5 He tempts people to infidelity when they are weak

2 Corinthians 2:10-11 He has schemes, he can work through our unforgiveness

2 Corinthians 11:3 He deceived Eve by his cunning and wants to lead us astray, too
